SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

This is a summary of the annual report for the PENNSYLVANIA SOCIAL SERVICES UNION HEALTH & WELFARE FUND, EIN 23-2029140, Plan No. 501, for period May, 2008 through April, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has a contract with Cigna Group Insurance to pay certain disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending April, 2009 were \$112,418.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$ 2,432,530 as of April, 2009 compared to \$ 2,155,711 as of April, 2008. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$ 276,819. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$ 3,562,635 including employer contributions of \$ 3,520,999, employee contributions of \$ 19,558, and earnings from investments of \$ 122,044.

Plan expenses were \$ 3,285,816. These expenses include \$ 263,581 in administrative expense and \$ 3,022,235 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiares.
